Description

The Center for Leadership and Innovation in Medical Education (CLIME) is launching a Clinical Teaching Certificate Program. The certificate is intended for educators in the clinical setting, regardless of background, type and/or level of learner. The curriculum consists of six 2 hour live online sessions and six online modules led by subject matter experts in the UW School of Medicine. There is no cost associated with enrolling into the certificate.

Certificate Program Mission

- **1**. Increase the clinical teaching skills of faculty who interact with learners (students, residents, and fellows)
- 2. Foster a shared mental model of excellent teaching
- **3.** Increase professional satisfaction of faculty in their role as teachers
- **4.** Highlight the efforts of faculty working to grow as teachers
- **5.** Offer an institution-wide, standardized, durable curriculum available to all faculty

Curriculum and Evaluation

Completion of the Certificate requires attendance at six live two-hour session and completion of self-paced online modules after each session. Each module will take up to 1-2 hours to complete. Curricular content includes peer-reviewed literature, worksheets, teaching exercises, case studies and reflective exercises. An online learning management system (TalentLMS) will be utilized for tracking and feedback by UWSOM content experts. Upon completion of the program, participants will receive a UWSOM Clinical Teaching Certificate from the UW Office of Faculty Affairs. Completing the certificate within 1 year is recommended, but to allow greater flexibility the Certificate requirements may be completed within 3-4 years.


