March 21 - 22, 2024 <u>20th Annual Reproductive & Gynecology Health Update</u> (Formerly known as Women's Healthcare Update)

(Virtual) This conference is an annual update for health care providers who provide care to women+ on relevant topics. The topics are selected from suggestions from previous course attendees, areas with substantial change, and controversial subjects where medical opinions may differ. The purpose is to provide a clinical update for providers who care for these patients in an outpatient setting.



April 26, 2024 23rd Annual Clinical Cardiology Pearls for Primary Care

(Virtual) This course is tailored for a primary care audience and is intended to provide practical, up-todate information on commonly encountered cardiovascular diseases. University of Washington School of Medicine faculty will teach participants using case-based lectures and an audience response system to encourage interactive dialogue.



August 11 - 13, 2024 Emergency Radiology 2024

(In-Person) This course will provide an update and review on the imaging appearance of trauma and stroke, with a special focus on the key aspects of diagnosis and management, from the perspective of a regional network of care. Content will include indications for a higher level of care, radiology considerations for evacuation and transport, Quality Improvement, lessons learned, "what the surgeon needs to know," implications for radiology from the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma 2022 Update (Gray Book), and local responsibilities in regional disaster response.




September 9 - 13, 2024 52nd Annual Advances in Family Medicine and Primary Care
